

4th Annual Dream Bigger, Aim Higher, Reach Farther ISI Team Competition October 4 – October 6, 2024 ISI Endorsement #38502700

Eligibility: This Competition is open to all individual ISI members – all ages (Tots through Adults!). Membership must be current through October 6, 2024. All skaters must represent a current ISI Administrative Member. Proof of ISI membership is required for all competitors. *Skaters may only compete at their highest test levels registered with ISI by September 16, 2024*.

<u>Registration</u>: Competitors are required to check-in at the registration desk at least one hour before their first event. Proof of ISI membership should be presented at this time.

<u>Competition Standards</u>: The Dream Bigger, Aim Higher, Reach Farther Competition will be using rules and regulations from the **2024 ISI Handbook**. Rule Revisions are available on the ISI website <u>www.skateisi.org</u>. All skaters, coaches and parents should be familiar with the performance rules for each event.

Entry Forms and Entry Deadline: Entry forms should be mailed or turned into the Huntsville Skating School & Training Academy. **Entry deadline is September 16, 2024.** The coach or rink manager should also review each form to verify that all information is correct. Late entries must be approved by the Competition Director. There will be a \$50.00 late fee charged to all late applications that are accepted. <u>There will be no refunds.</u>

Entry Fees:

Single Entries: \$60.00 first event - \$20.00 each additional event Family Entries: \$100.00 for a total of 3 events - \$20.00 each additional event Team Events: \$15.00 per skater Late Entries: \$50.00 additional if allowed by Competition Director

Music: Music must be EMAILED to <u>hssta@icesportscenter.com</u>. Music (MP3 or MP4 format) must be identified with skater name, event name and rink name (e.g. Jane Smith_ Freestyle 2 Lt Ent_ ABC Rink). **DEADLINE** for emailed music is September 26, 2024. Competitors must have available a backup copy of their competition music either on a CD or on a cell phone and it must be immediately available rink side when the skater competes. If the phone does not have the standard round headset connector an appropriate adapter, such as an Apple Lightning connector or Samsung USB-C adapter is required to be attached. the phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode, screen unlocked and volume turned to maximum.

Awards: Awards will be given during the resurface following your event. Medals will be awarded for first through sixth place. Team Point Trophies will be presented at the end of the competition for first through third place.

Schedules: Schedules will be emailed to team coaches and competitors approximately one week prior to the competition. Schedule will also be available on Entryeeze.

Facility: Huntsville Ice Sports Center is a two-sheet facility. 1. NHL size 200x85 and 2.Olympic size 200x100

Maneuvers will be performed with few connecting moves and minimal choreography. There should be only one attempt per element. Additional maneuvers, such as any jump, spin or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

> There is no penalty given for the quantity of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers performed in the Pre-Alpha - Beta levels. Only the quality of these maneuvers is judged.

Stroking & Jump/Spin Events

STROKING

Stroking: Alpha through Delta

Forward, both directions, until told to stop; Strokes, crossovers on the ends are judged as of 9/1/22. (All in same event will go together and wear numbers)

Stroking: Freestyle 1-4 (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook) Forward at least one direction and backward at least on direction – no pattern; just turn or change directions when told. Strokes and crossovers are judged (NO CUTBACKS). (All in same event will go together and wear numbers)

Stroking: Freestyle 5 and up (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook) Forward and backward in a figure eight pattern: One figure eight forward, turn backward in center, one figure eight backward, then stop. Strokes and crossovers are judged (NO CUTBACKS). (will go one at a time; no numbers)

JUMP & SPIN:

Two skaters enter the ice as a team. The first skater performs their choice of a required jump 2 times, followed by the second skater performing their choice of a required spin 2 times. Only the best attempt of each required element will be judged. Only the technical accuracy of the required element is judged – the difficulty of the chosen element is not considered during judging for this event.

ALL JUMP & SPIN EVENTS will be done on ¹/₂ ICE ONLY.

Category Levels:

Low	Both skaters must be in Pre-Alpha to Delta levels only.
Bronze	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 1-3 / Bronze levels or below.
Silver	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 4-5 / Silver levels or below.
Gold	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 6-7 / Gold levels or below.
Platinun	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 8-10 / Platinum levels or below.

	Freestyle 5 and higher skaters will skate a Figure 8 pattern, forward and backward. One figure
	eight forward, Mohawk in the center ice, one figure eight backward, stop. Strokes and
	crossovers (or cutbacks) are judged. Will go one at a time. (This is a created event. The pattern and rules
	for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)
INTEDDDET	IVE SPOTLIGHT (This is a created event. The rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)
	1. The first skater in each warm-up event group will be asked to report to the ice monitor early

- to hear the music for the first time. All other skaters will hear the music during warm-up and just before they skate.
- 2. During warm-up, we will play music two more times for all skaters
- 3. All but first two skaters are taken somewhere they can't hear the music
- 4. While first skaters performs; second skater will sit/stand with back to the ice surface, face to the wall, to hear the music one more time. Same procedure to be repeated for each additional skater in the warm-up.

Props will be available and skaters may look at them during the warm-up time- skaters may use one or more props, but they must be returned to the prop area immediately after each skater skates.

SPOTLIGHTS - PROPS

There will NOT be a curtain and space is limited. Props should only be brought in one warm up group prior to the skater's event. Props should be removed during the warm-up following each skater's events. All props will be down by the Zamboni end of the rink.
