Make-Up Policy & Transfers

We value the relationship that our students develop with our teachers through regular, consistent instruction. We assign teachers at the start of each term based on the initial enrollment to ensure the best possible student-teacher ratio. Students are encouraged to attend the specific class and day for which they are registered. Students make the most progress by regular attendance and practice. Students may make-up one class per 8 weeks of classes missed due to illness or personal conflict. Classes may not be made up the week of progress reports or the last week of the term. In order to attend a make-up class, students must notify us at least one day in advance so that we can be sure that we have the correct number of teachers on-hand. Transferring to another class mid-term is discouraged. If a transfer is necessary, please consult the Skating Director.

Registration After the Start of the Term

For Alpha classes and up, students may be added to classes during the first half of each term, and class costs will be pro-rated based on the remaining number of classes, but only if more than one week has been missed. If only one week has been missed, the student may make up that week. For Beginner/Pre-Alpha classes, students may be added to classes during the first two weeks of the term -- after that, they are asked to wait until the next Introductory classes are offered (usually every four weeks). If only one week has been missed, the student may arrange to make up that week. As long as students are registered for classes in an upcoming term, they are welcome to arrange for private lessons in the interim.
