REQUIREMENTS

- Be a Delta level or higher skater between the ages of 9-18
- Commit to 1 year of service as a volunteer from March through February of the following year
- Attend 1 mandatory training session per year
- Participate in three major events (fundraisers, competition help, etc.) as a volunteer for one year
- Attend basics classes and provide off-ice mentoring for 1 hour per week for Skate For Our Future
- Provide permission to the Ice Chalet Club to publicize your photo and photos of you participating in events in the lobby of the Ice Chalet, on the web, or through other means
- To be a mentor to all skaters regardless of age or skating level
- To be on time for all BLADES commitments (volunteer hours, trainings, etc.)
- To find a substitute if you cannot attend your scheduled time and all substitutes must be a currently trained BLADES member
- To abide by all behavioral expectations (to be reviewed at training) for mentors at all times, both in and out of the Ice Chalet
- To maintain satisfactory academic progress and share with BLADES administrators academic records as requested. BLADES administrators will treat all information shared in a confidential manner.
