The Robert Unger ISI Competition is held here in Knoxville every Spring. This is the oldest continuously running ISI recreational skating competition in the world! Club members donate many volunteer hours to make this event possible. In addition, the Ice Chalet team attends at least one out-of-town competition each year, and the Club helps with expenses.

◆ Skate-a-thon/Community Support

Fundraisers such as a Skate-a-thon and Skating with the Stars help raise money for local community programs such as the Special Olympics or disadvantaged children.

◆ Nutcracker On Ice

Each year, the enchanting music of Tchaikovsky and the Nutcracker Christmas story are brought to life on a sheet of ice. Volunteers help with costumes, spotlights, props, tickets, program sales, dressing rooms, our "Nutcracker Memories" shop, and hot cocoa sales.

◆ Skate for Our Future & Team Blades

This special project is designed to enhance and empower the lives of disadvantaged children through the sport of ice skating. Mentors are assigned to the children with the aim of improving their overall skating and life success.

◆ ProSkaters

ProSkaters' Live Auditions and Performance Camp gives skaters a chance to work with some of the best choreographers in the show skating world.

◆ Annual Sportsmanship Trophy

The Club sponsors the Hans Brinker Noble Spirit Award for sportsmanship, presented each year during the *Nutcracker On Ice* shows!
