



The 56th Annual Robert Unger ISI Team Competition

Events are offered to all ages -- Tots through Adults!

All skaters must be current ISI members, and their relevant tests must have been registered with the national office by March 26, 2025.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS A 3-DAY COMPETITION! Events start Friday morning and end by mid-day Sunday. If you cannot attend Friday events, we will try to work with you, but we cannot guarantee that we can accommodate all schedule conflicts.

Entry Forms:

Team coaches should make sure all entry forms have the skater's ISI number and competition level on them. The coach or rink manager should also review each form to verify that all information is correct. **Entry deadline: March 26, 2025.**

Fees:

Fees for individual competitors will be \$55.00 for the first event. Each additional event is \$20.00. In partner events (pairs, couples, etc.) each skater will pay the additional fee of \$20.00. If the partner events are the skater's only events, s/he must pay the \$55.00 first event fee. If group events are the skater's only event, each skater must pay the \$15.00 event fee, but need not pay an individual fee. Late entries must be approved by the Competition Director; there is an extra \$50.00 late entry fee.

Registration & Check-in:

All skaters may begin picking up their competitor packets on Thursday afternoon starting at 5:00 pm. We have several practice sessions available for Thursday and during the competition -- see the Practice Ice form for details.

Competition Standards:

This competition will be conducted in accordance with the most recent edition of the ISI Handbook and any applicable revisions. (See ISI web site: www.skateisi.org)

Judges:

Each team must provide at least one certified judge for every 15 skaters, and all judges must be current professional members of the ISI. Coaches and judges will receive advance instructions either online or at a meeting to help ensure a smooth experience for their skaters.

Divisions:

In most cases we try to divide groups by the age categories recommended by the ISI. However, in cases of large or small enrollment, we do reserve the right to divide and combine the groups further.

Event Check-In:

All skaters should be at the rink one hour ahead of the scheduled event time, and check-in with the ice monitor one warm-up/event group before they are scheduled to compete (usually about 30 minutes ahead). Events may run early, so be prepared!

Music:

Music must be in mp3 or mp4 format and emailed to music@chaleticerinks.com by April 15. The source file must be labeled with skater's name, level, event name, and rink, i.e.,

Elaine Smith_Delta_CharSpotlight_ABC Ice Rink. Any late music or music upload changes will be subject to a fee of \$20, no exceptions. Competitors must have available a backup copy on a cell phone or other device and it must be immediately available rinkside when the skater competes. The phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode, screen unlocked, and volume turned to maximum.

Photos:

Competition events will be professionally photographed and available for purchase.

Accounting Reviews:

Requests for accounting reviews must be made in writing and submitted by the team coach or supervisor to the chief referee. All review requests must include a fee of \$50.00, which will be refunded should the protest be upheld. Reviews concerning judgment will not be considered. The chief referee's decision will be final.

Awards:

Medals will be presented to first through sixth place winners. Team Trophies: First-Place Out-of-Town Team Trophy, Second Place Out-of-Town Team Trophy, Sportsmanship Trophy, Percentage Trophy, Kaleidoskate, Synchro, and Production Teams.
