The 49th Annual Robert Unger ISI Competition will be held in Knoxville at the Ice Chalet the weekend of May 4-6, 2018. This is the oldest continuously running recreational figure skating competition, and it is endorsed by the international Ice Sports Industry (ISI).

The history of recreational competition continues to build as each new generation participates in innovations of the ISI program. The Robert Unger philosophy of "something for everyone" is the focus of this event, as skaters of all ages and skill levels can compete against skaters of similar age and skill level.

Events include Tots, Pre-Alpha through Delta, Freestyle, Open Freestyle, Open Pairs, Footwork, Stroking, Figures, Dance, Pairs, Team Compulsories, Solo Compulsories, Artistic Skating, Production, Jump & Spin, Ensemble, Synchronized Team Events, Interpretive Spotlight, Spotlight, Family Spotlight, Couples Spotlight. We use our stage lighting and follow spots for all spotlight events!

We expect approximately 250 competitors from 9-10 different skating rinks to attend this three-day event along with their families and coaches. States represented recently include Alabama, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia.

Show on Sunday:

On Sunday at approximately 1:00 p.m., several rinks will participate in a special show depicting the history of ice skating, "The Story of Skating," featuring special guest Janet Lynn, the 1972 Olympic bronze medalist, two-time World Championships medalist, and five-time U.S. National Champion.
